Lithia & Driveway Fields 2025 Highlights

This Year:

- Generated \$13.37 million in estimated economic impact.
- The park's overall estimated economic impact exceeds \$185 million from 739 events since 2008.
- Since 2008, spending by visitors to Medford (\$78 million) has more than doubled the park construction cost (\$32.5 million).
- The park has received over 3.5 million visits since 2008.
- Set all-time records for youth fastpitch (339) and adult slowpitch softball (366) tournament participation.

Softball Teams Spark Solid Year for Sports Park Stimulus

Lithia & Driveway Fields set records for youth fastpitch and adult slowpitch softball team participation in 2025, helping the City of Medford's sports park achieve its second-best year ever for estimated economic impact. The park generated an estimated \$13,366,138 in economic stimulus from the impact of 1,790 sports teams and 46 events.

The economic performance was \$105,732 shy of the all-time record established in 2024, and it was only the third time in 18 years the facility surpassed the \$13 million mark.

Managed and maintained by the City of Medford, Lithia & Driveway Fields has now accounted for over \$185 million in economic stimulus since May 2008 – over 5.6 times the \$32.5 million facility construction cost.

The City's partnership with Legacy Sports produced a bumper crop of girls fastpitch softball teams with 238 playing in seven tournaments, and 134 in four new fall tournaments. Factoring in the large North Medford Spring Break Tournament (44 teams) and the Valley South College Exposure Tournament (32), a grand total of 339 fastpitch squads competed in Medford, a 47 percent surge from the record-setting 2024 count.

Similarly, the partnership with Legacy Sports and local tournament directors resulted in 366 adult slowpitch teams playing in 19 tournaments – new records for both categories.

The park's signature events – youth baseball tournaments – attracted 373 teams for 10 tournaments, five shy of the all-time record set in 2024. All five spring tournaments sold out within

six minutes, with dozens of teams on waitlists unable to be accepted due to not enough available fields and umpires to meet white-hot demand.

The Cascade Collegiate Conference soccer championships, held in Medford for the second straight year as a result of hosting efforts of the City, Travel Medford, and the Southern Oregon Sports Commission, contributed \$455,752 to the overall economic impact total. The men's and women's tournament conducted the second week of November featured 16 NAIA college soccer teams from Montana, Idaho, Washington and Oregon resulting in the use of 717 hotel room nights.

Youth soccer accounted for most field use in the multi-sport complex, primarily Rogue Valley Timbers Soccer Club practices and games. RVT is the largest club program in the state of Oregon, and its annual Memorial Day tournament attracted over 200 teams to Medford, with 70 playing at Lithia & Driveway Fields – a \$1.1 million economic boost over three days alone.

Lithia & Driveway Fields also serves as the home venue for Rogue Community College, St. Mary's School, and Cascade Christian High teams. The CCHS football team won the state Class 3A championship.

Overall, the 46 events and 2,964 games played in 2025 attracted approximately 238,462 park visitors. Total park visitation since 2008 has now exceeded 3.5 million.

About Lithia & Driveway Fields

Lithia & Driveway Fields (*formerly U.S. Cellular Community Park*), is a community park owned and operated by the City of Medford. The sports park is the largest installation of synthetic turf in the United States by a municipality (*1.5 million square feet*).

- The 5-field softball/baseball complex opened on May 9, 2008 and has hosted over 80,000 youth and adult games.
- The multi-sport complex opened in May 2009 and is the home of the Rogue Valley Timbers, Oregon's largest youth soccer club.
- U.S. Cellular paid \$650,000 for park naming-rights in 2005. At the time it was the largest naming-rights agreement for a municipal recreational facility in Oregon history.
- In 2021, Medford-based Lithia Motors and its subsidiary, Driveway, obtained park naming rights for a period of five years in an agreement valued at \$725,000.

Significance of the Economic Impact Report

In most communities, parks and recreation agencies are the engines of tourism and economic development. Recreational facilities like Lithia & Driveway Fields attract tourists, businesses and retirees, and enhance real estate values. A common mistake is to merely provide decision-makers with financial reports on the revenue and expenses of these facilities instead of illustrating economic impact and the broader value of the community's investment. Economic impact reports are estimates and are easily inflated.

Methodology and Data Collection

This study closely follows the economic impact data-collection and calculation methods set forth by Texas A&M researcher Dr. John L. Crompton in his landmark 1999 book, Measuring the Economic Impact.

Crompton contends only spending by visitors to Medford is meaningful in economic impact reports. Expenditures by tournament participants who reside in or near Medford are not included in Personal Income and Jobs calculations because of the likelihood their money would have been spent in the community on other forms of entertainment. The economic impact report also does not calculate the impact of participants in City-sponsored sports leagues that utilize the sports park.

The questionnaire used for this study generated spending data from tournament directors regarding approximate amounts each team spent on entry fees, food and beverages, entertainment, retail shopping, transportation expenses and lodging.

Conclusions

Total Spending: The park hosted 46 tournaments, events or contests that attracted 1,790 teams. These teams spent an estimated \$7,224,940 in hard dollars.

Visitor Spending: The 911 visiting teams spent \$5.46 million. Softball team size is estimated at 14; baseball, fastpitch teams and soccer is estimated at 18.

Sales: Total Spending by all tournament participants (*local and visiting teams*) multiplied by a "ripple effect" of 85 cents for every dollar spent, for a grand total of \$13,366,138. The 1.85 multiplier is based on Crompton studies of tournaments in a city of similar size.

Personal Income: This measure reports the direct, indirect and induced spending of visiting teams only. For every dollar spent by tournament visitors, 65 cents of personal income accrued within the community in the form of employee wages, salaries and proprietary income. Simply stated, the sports park theoretically generated \$38.97 for each Medford resident.

Jobs: If one job is created for every \$72,935 — Medford's approximate median income — tournaments helped sustain 75 jobs in the community based on the direct spending of visiting teams. The figure refers to both full- and part-time jobs, and it assumes the local economy is operating at full capacity and that there is no slack to absorb demand created by events.

Totals do not reflect impact of Harry & David Field.
